SUMMER READING LIST – 2023

DUE: MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 11TH

Students accepted and entering class after school begins, will have two weeks to complete the required assignment.

Students entering grades 9th - 12th are required to read the listed book for their perspective grade level. Each student is to complete and type an assignment for the novel, according to the following instructions:

-  **Times New Roman**
-  **Double Space**
-  **Size 12 Font**

1. List the title & author
2. Read Each chapter closely and bullet 10 key points with the page number for each point. If the book does not have chapter numbers, complete 10 key point for every 10 pages
3. Key points: tell about character changes, rising and falling action, conflict, setting, tone, and mood
4. Select 5 characters and describe each using 4 - 6 sentences
5. Explain the climax using 5 - 7 sentences
6. Explain the resolution using 5 - 7 sentences
7. Select 2 quotes [include page # - speaker of quote – who is being spoken to] - Explain the essence of the quote using your own words (3 - 5) sentences each
8. Explain the theme using 8 - 10 sentences, support theme with at least two examples from the novel; [Page # must accompany each quote]
9. **This assignment must be submitted to either Ms. Beatty or Mrs. Gross by 9/11/2023.**
10. This assignment will be graded and credited to students' Quarter I English or Social Studies Class.

AP Literature: Students are required to read both novels listed in the **AP Literature & Composition** section, and complete two different assignments as follows:

1. Choose any one of the novels and complete the assignment defined above for grades 9th – 12th
2. Read the other novel. Bullet 10 key points for each chapter and write a two-page summary: 4 - 5 paragraphs with 6 - 9 sentences per paragraph

TYPED ASSIGNMENT CRITERIA:

- ✓ Students MUST closely read the novel and use their own words for each part of the assignment. ***Work must not be copied directly from the book except when using quotes***
- ✓ **DO NOT PLAGIARIZE** by using any information from the Internet, and work must not be copied from or shared with another student. **Plagiarism equals zero on the assignment**
- ✓ Points will be deducted for poor editing; you must proofread your work for errors in spelling, grammar, sentence structure, and content.
